Based within the CSA, this cluster aims to provide a platform for researchers working in Canada and beyond to discuss their work on various elements of economic sociology and political economy.

The Economic Sociology RC will be awarding a best graduate student paper for the 2025 CSA.

The rules are as follows:

- The paper must be approved for presentation (and subsequently presented) at the Canadian Sociological Association <u>Annual Conference</u> in one of the Economic Sociology RC Sessions
- The paper must be unpublished and not yet approved for publication
- The author must be a registered student (MA or Ph.D. student) when the paper is presented
- An author may submit only one paper for consideration
- Papers co-written with faculty are not eligible
- Papers co-written with other students only are eligible
- Paper length may not exceed 10,000 words (40 pages) maximum, including bibliography and appendices
- An author cannot have received the award in the previous three years
- Eligible papers should be sent, along with evidence of being a student, ie. copy of student card, etc. to Dean Curran at <u>dcurran@ucalgary.ca</u>
- The deadline for submission of the paper is **April 30, 2025**.
