

The <u>Sociology of Health Research Cluster</u> is now accepting nominations for our Best Student Paper Award. The paper must address the themes of the cluster, broadly defined as a focus on health, illness, and/or medicine. The paper can be empirical or theoretical in focus, but should involve original research (e.g., not a literature review or synthesis).

One recipient will be selected from the nominees.

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

Primary Author of Nominated Paper

- The primary author must be a member of CSA.
- The primary author must be an MA or PhD student.

#### Authorship of Nominated Paper

• The paper can be solo-authored **OR** co-authored with another student.

# Conference Presentation of Nominated Paper

• The paper is going to be presented at the CSA Conference.

### Nominated Paper Format

- The paper is no longer than 10,000 words.
- Submissions can be in French or English.

#### **Submission Instructions:**

Papers must be submitted no later than May 15<sup>th</sup> 2025, and we plan to make a final decision by May 30<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Submit your paper as a PDF file. Please also include the following information:

- 1. Name, email address, affiliation, and student-level of all authors.
- 2. The CSA Conference session in which the paper will be presented.
- 3. Authors are welcome, but not required, to identify members of an equity deserving group (e.g., "I identify as a member of an equity deserving group" is sufficient).
